




Red Envelope Holiday Brunch was a huge success!

The AAUW Southeast Valley Branch Holiday Funds Brunch was held on Saturday, December 9, 2023, at the Sun Lakes Country Club. It was a wonderful success. Those in attendance enjoyed the festivities. The beautiful Angel center pieces were lovely, and the brunch was delicious. Our Arizona State President shared her personal history and the vision for the future of Arizona's AAUW. Jodi Ligget spoke about the battle going on in Arizona regarding abortions. Will Arizona keep the 15 week ban or go back to the 1846 territorial law of completely prohibiting abortion? She gave us an inside look into her approach to the steps needed to interact with the legislature. She talked about the Arizona constitutional change that signatures are being collected for now and the uphill battle that it is facing in the current Arizona legislature. Jodi is incredibly knowledgeable and articulate, and she presented the issues facing the state in a nonpartisan way.

Our generous members donated over \$3000 to the various national funds which allow AAUW to support areas such as education and leadership. Now more than ever, we as members of AAUW must support the important work done by our national organization. AAUW was founded in 1881, and it continues to work tirelessly on behalf of women and girls to advance laws,



policies and practices that ensure equity in education, employment and economic security-and equal justice for all. Thank you all for supporting the work of AAUW.



AZ Ballot Initiative for Reproductive Freedom

Self-determination of one's reproductive health decisions: This was chosen as AAUW Arizona's Number One priority for 2023-2024 action. And this is the year Arizonans are mobilizing to guarantee to Arizona women the freedom to make their own reproductive health decisions. Nine out of 10 Arizonans agree these decisions should be made free from political interference.

The ballot initiative would amend the Arizona constitution to include a woman's right to make her own decision on abortion. It will restore abortion access in Arizona by preventing politicians from limiting abortion before fetal viability.

AAUW Arizona's action plan is a statewide, branch by branch, member by member plan and includes joining in the collection of the 383,923 signatures needed by July 3, 2024, for the November 2024 election. The next step would be an endorsement of the ballot initiative by AAUW AZ. And finally your VOTE YES in November 2024 for the initiative after it has qualified for the ballot.



The petition will be available to sign at the January meeting.


