Update on the Voucher Program from Save Our Schools Arizona

Recently, “Arizona’s ESA voucher program officially reached \$1 billion in annual costs, as enrollment in the program reached 96,802 students. Taxpayer dollars are siphoned away from local public schools to private schools with no requirements for financial reporting, academic standards, or safety oversight. Taxpayers are providing a \$1 billion subsidy for primarily wealthier families who were already choosing (and affording) private options.”

Tell the House: All Workers Deserve Paid Sick Days (from AAUW.org)

Did you know? There are 25 million working people in the U.S. who lack access to even a single paid sick day. The Healthy Families Act is expected to be introduced in Congress in late November. The bill would allow all workers in the U.S. to earn up to seven paid sick days a year to recover from illness, care for a sick family member, access preventive care, or seek support related to sexual or domestic violence.

AAUW Announced Collaboration with League of Women Voters' Unite and Rise 8.5 Campaign.

The following is AAUW's November 7 news release about the collaboration:

The American Association of University Women (AAUW) is proud to join the League of Women Voters of the United States and fellow women-led organizations as part of the Grassroots Power Partners initiative, a key component of the League's *Unite and Rise 8.5* campaign. Together, these partners are mobilizing women and communities across the country to expand civic participation, foster equity, and build a stronger, more inclusive democracy.

This latest partnership uplifts AAUW's long-standing commitment to open and fair elections that are broadly accessible to all voters, nonpartisan voter education efforts that will promote equitable political participation and expanding voting rights. Launched in May 2025, *Unite and Rise 8.5* is the League's nationwide effort to engage 8.5 million people in defending democracy and advancing voter participation. This next phase — running from November 2025 through January 2026 — focuses on partnership and collective action.

"Education and civic participation have always gone hand in hand," said Gloria L. Blackwell, CEO of AAUW. "For over 140 years, our mission has been to empower women to use knowledge as a catalyst for action — to turn awareness into advocacy and leadership into lasting change. Through this partnership, we're helping women across the country strengthen their voices, mobilize their communities, and shape a democracy that truly represents us all."

AAUW's network of branches and members will collaborate with the League and other partners to promote civic education, increase voter participation, and deepen community connections. Together, these organizations aim to amplify the power of women-led advocacy and inspire civic action in every community.

"Throughout history, women-led organizations have stood at the center of America's progress-shaping the nation's conscience, guiding movements, and anchoring the march towards lasting change," said Celina Stewart, CEO of the League of Women Voters of the United States. "When women come together to lead, we don't just expand participation, we expand possibility. Partnering with organizations like AAUW allows us to harness our collective power to educate, engage, and empower communities

across the country. Together, we're building an inclusive, multiracial democracy that reflects the leadership, strength, and vision of women everywhere."
